First Aid at Work 3 DAY COURSE

This nationally accredited course meets the requirements that the Health and Safety Executive (HSE) insist companies must have regarding qualified first aiders in the workplace.

The course is available as a 3 day initial or 2 day re-qualification course equipping you with the skills to deal with major and minor emergencies in the workplace.

Who should attend?

Industrial workers, leisure and hospitality, engineering environments, corporate.

Paediatric First Aid 2 DAY COURSE

This 2 day course meets Ofsted guidelines. It teaches you the relevant first aid skills when dealing with children and babies.

Also available as a 1 day Emergency Paediatric First Aid and a new 3 day combined First Aid at Work and Paediatric course.

Who should attend?

Ideal for those who work in settings that require both first aiders and paediatric first aiders, such as schools or sports clubs.

Catastrophic First Aid ½ DAY COURSE

This course is designed to teach people how to use life saving products such as tourniquets and haemostatic dressings (dressings that will control and stop an arterial bleed in 60 seconds).

Who should attend?

Members of the general public, industrial workers, tree surgeons, anyone working in populated public areas.

This course is ideal for Nordic Walking Instructors/Leaders, Duke of Edinburgh Award students, Public Services students, Teaching staff responsible for running expedition training.

Fire Marshal/Fire Awareness Training
